## VIBRANT COLOUR & QUIRKY PATTERNS THE DELIGHTING CERAMICS OF RHONDA NADASDY

### GUEST ARTIST PROFILE

Wander the whimsical villages created by Rhonda Nadasdy, houses of vibrant colour, charming architecture and noisy chattering birds.

As an artist and primary school teacher from the Yarra Valley Rhonda's art is a joyous exploration of her world and the free spirited children who have influenced her.

Re-interpreting her students use of vibrant colours, bold lines, peculiar shapes and quirky patterns, Rhonda captures their sense of joy and freedom. Experimenting with a variety of hand crafting techniques including commercial tools and found objects, she develops a delightful array of textures and patterns.

Initially inspired by children's drawings and the architecture of Friedrich Hundertwasser, Rhonda has lovingly crafted ranges of highly detailed houses that have evolved into unique and distinctive collections.

Imprinting blocks of clay with her designs, Rhonda scoops out the inside before adding chimneys and birds. After the first firing, each house is meticulously and joyously brought to life with a variety of coloured under-glazes and gloss glazes.

Rhonda Nadasdy's ceramics are more than beautiful objects, they inspire nostalgia, depicting vibrant, eclectic homes tugging at memories of our childhood to which we cannot help but smile.

GUEST ARTIST PROFILE

From exuberant, bright delights to exquisitely monochromatic mixes of stone, metal and leather. The jewellery of Jenny Reid is irresistible in its unique detail and balance of symmetry and form. Looking at her jewellery, you feel both her training as a designer and her sense of joy and freedom in the recycled materials she chooses to use. Each piece is a handcrafted one-off original, creating an evolving collection of intrinsically beautiful artistic works.

With an extensive background in the creative workspace, Jenny uses a range of materials, combining leather, vintage and recycled materials with her own sterling silver work. Her jewellery affords a sense of the exotic, through its mix of semi-precious stones and vintage and artisan pieces, sourced from around the world.

Passionate about creating one-off pieces that cannot be mass produced, Jenny up-cycles vintage

jewellery to lead the creative process, ensuring every piece is completely unique. Inspired by the impulse to create and design, jewellery making has become for her a process of necessary creative expression. Jenny's pieces are the products of continual experiments, with materials and ideas gathered from all aspects of her life: from study, to travel and her home in coastal New South Wales.

Jenny's bespoke jewellery has a physical and visual tactility which emphasises the beauty of their craftsmanship, making them utterly moreish. Her visual sensibility shows an acute sensitivity to the contemporary woman's style.

Jenny's work is available in her local area of design, Far North Coast NSW, and in parts of New South Wales, Queensland and Victoria.
